Overview

LNZRT and Route are providing paid sound engineer training and shadowing opportunities to three young people from Waltham Forest.

[Route](#) and [LNZRT](#) will be programming a series of music industry events for young people in Waltham Forest between August and October. The events will encompass live music, creative workshops and panel talks and are designed to create opportunities for pathways into music careers both on and off stage.

As part of the programme we will be providing three aspiring sound technicians a training session and shadow shift during the Blackhorse Road event with experienced engineers.

Training will be provided by Head Engineers at much loved grassroots music venues MOTH Club and The Shacklewell Arms. They have also worked as front of house for the likes of Tirzah, Goat Girl, Mica Levi & more.

There will also be opportunities to continue this role throughout the series between August and October.
