

Avenue Road Estate **Key Regeneration Updates:**



It is expected that the determination status of the planning application will be announced early next year in the planning committee meeting. Waltham Forest council will be writing to you to inform you about the next steps in the regeneration process following this.

Over the past month, Bellway Homes along with the council held exhibition events in November where residents were able to find out more about the final development proposals for the estate.

Bellway also organised a study visit last month for residents to visit one of their development sites in Beckton (see Feedback from Bellway Study Visit section for more information).

In preparation for the regeneration, Waltham Forest Council have appointed a dedicated Decant & Allocation officer for the Avenue Road Estate that will be working with residents early next year around the rehousing strategy to ensure that each household will be housed suitably in a home that meets their needs as part of the regeneration process.

Michelle Carroll will be starting her role with the council as your Decant & Allocation officer from 9th January 2023 and will be available to meet at the project shops from Thursday 12th January onwards.

Feedback from Exhibition Events:



Bellway Homes & PRP architects held exhibition events on 11th & 12th November which was attended by 68 residents. Residents were informed about the latest plans submitted as part of the planning application for the redevelopment of the Avenue Road Estate.

Some of the development highlights included:

- 242 council homes for existing residents
- A further 378 private and affordable homes
- A new public square for community events and new greener public realm
- New ground floor spaces for retail, community and leisure uses
- New space for the Nexus Centre, a local performance arts organization
- 161 new trees
- A bespoke arts and culture strategy for the local area
- Building heights from 22 storeys to three storeys. The tallest building will be to the north of the site. The tallest social housing block will be 18 storeys.
- Over £20m of social value benefits including 54 apprenticeships, 242 jobs for local people, and around 1,000 hours of training for local people.

Feedback from Bellway Study Visit to Beckton:



Bellway Homes arranged a study visit for Avenue Road Estate residents to visit one of their redevelopment schemes at Beckton Parkside last month on Thursday 24th November.

23 residents were in attendance. At the visit residents viewed the internal layout of the marketing suite, communal areas inside one of the blocks, bike store/refuse facilities, and community spaces.
