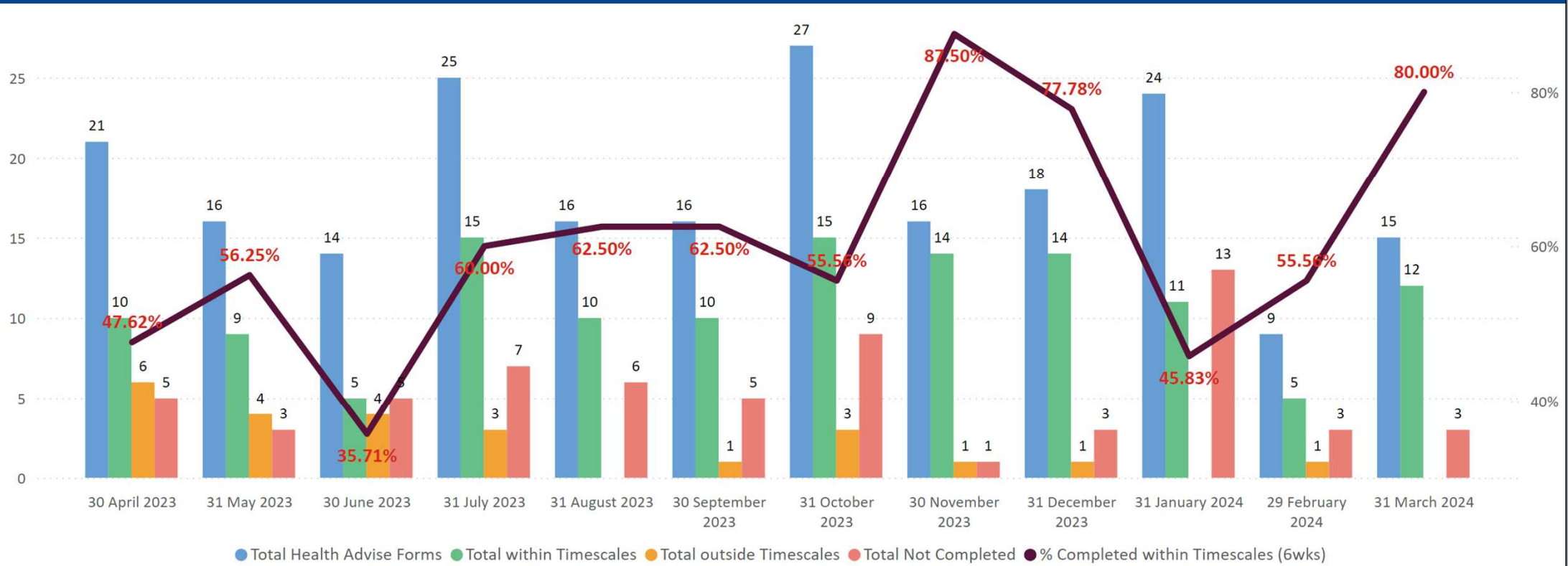

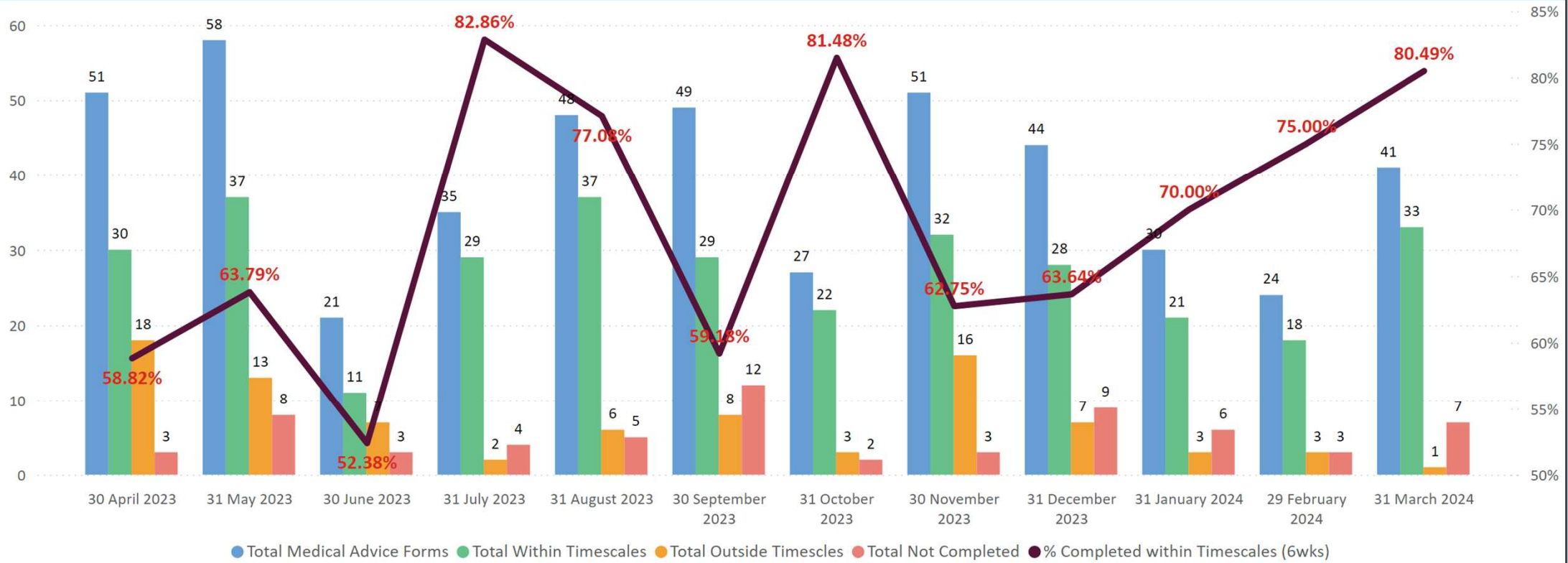

Health Advise Forms Required Occupational Therapy

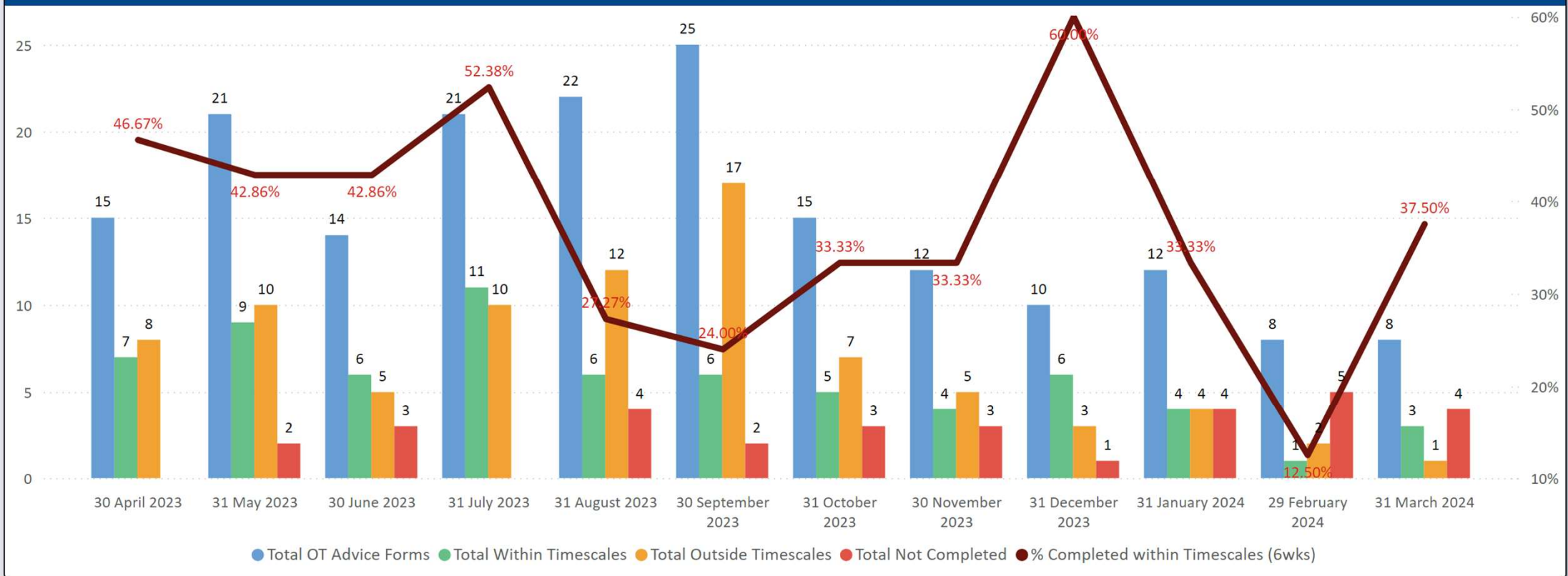

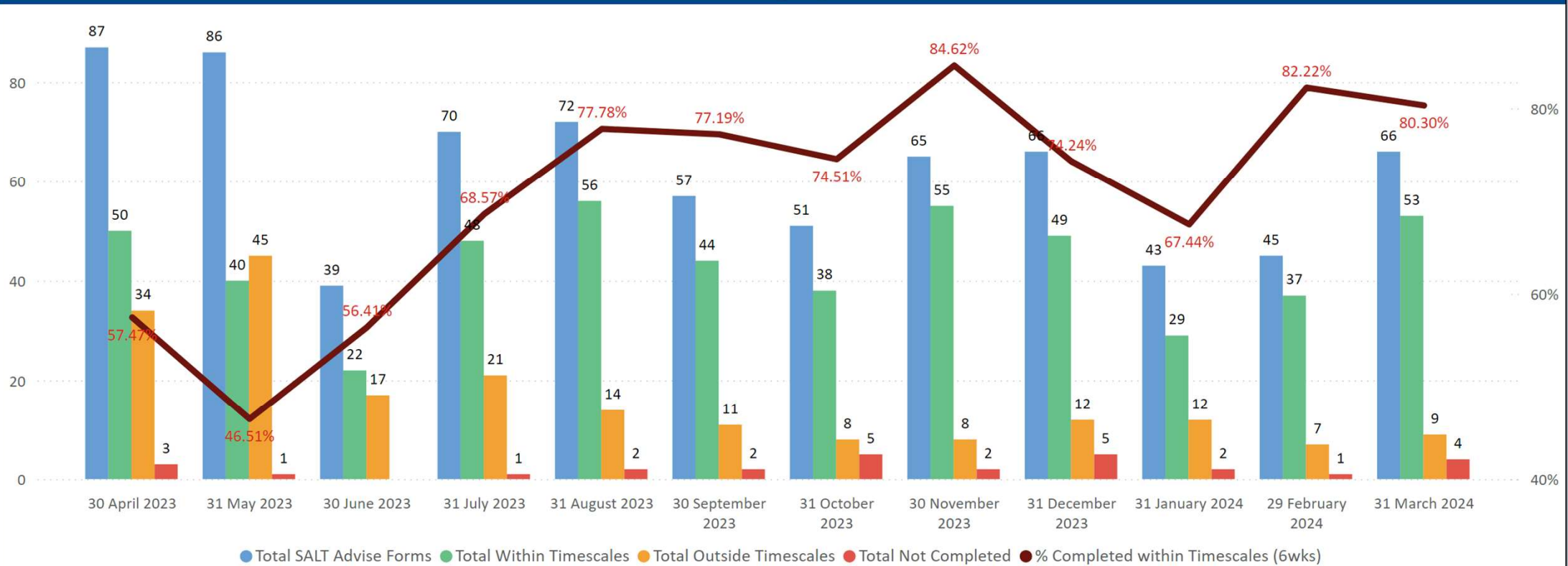

Comments on the 6 week timescales for reports

- Overall compliance has improved for all professional groups with medicals showing a steady increase. The staff have met with the DMO and DCO at an away day for discussion around the 6 week return.
- Where the reports are judged 'amber' this is because the report is submitted late but still within the month of reports
- Where reports are judged 'red' the report is late and outside of the month of reporting
- The reports are monitored on a fortnightly basis child by child and a reminder sent if needed

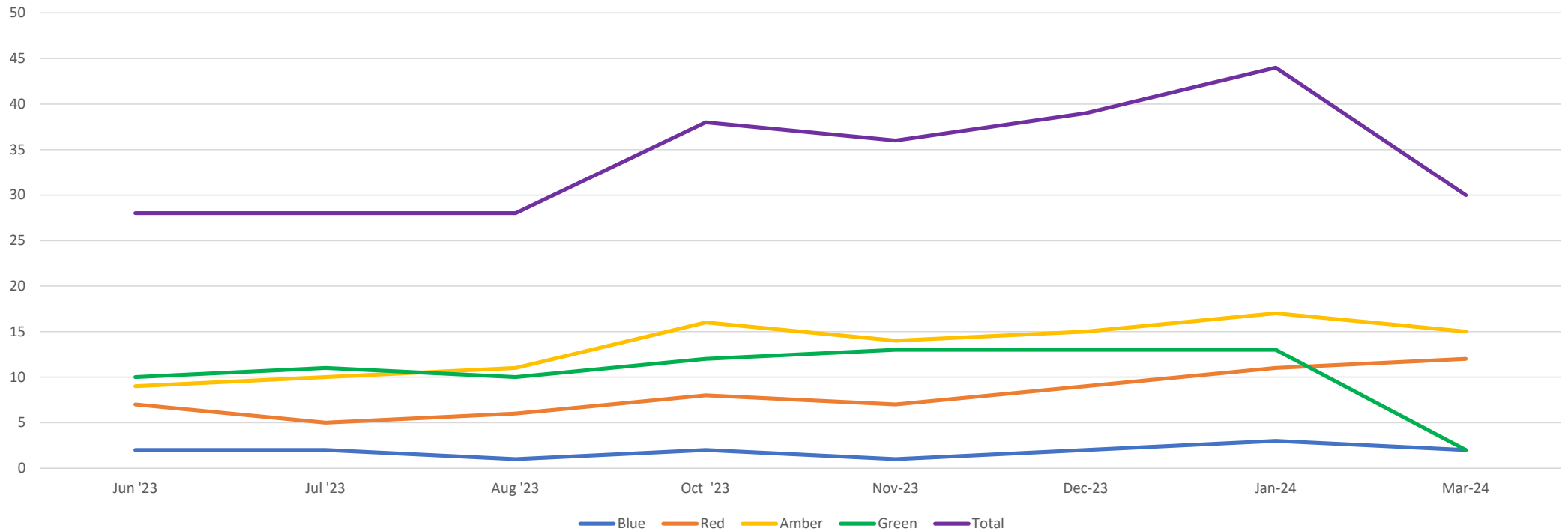


Dynamic Support Register

Comments on the Dynamic Support Register



- There continue to be a regular number of referrals to the register including 5 children in March 2024
- The numbers on the register at amber remain approximately the same
- There has been a slight increase in the number of children who are considered 'red' on the register
- The children who were considered green on the register have reduced as risks have decreased and they have come off the register
- Issue continue to be challenging behaviours at home and at school with a number of children on part time timetables or out of school.
- The NELFT key workers have started interventions with children who are 'amber' on the list, with the aim of linking the children into local support networks e.g. through the use of their short breaks.
- Four young people have been referred to the NELFT PBS service
- Work is starting to establish an adults DSR for people with autism and no Learning disability
