PROVISION OF HOUSING ESTATE RESTRICTED AREA - MATSON COURT IG8 (T31(24))

The Waltham Forest (Housing Estates Car Parks) (No. 1) (Amendment No. 40) Order 2024

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on 13th June 2024 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be, in the Matson Court IG8 housing estate car park located just off The Bridle Path (off-street areas), to provide and regulate "at any time" waiting restrictions in the form of a Restricted Zone (no physical yellow line markings on the ground) with the exception of a total of 4 off-street unrestricted parking bays and 1 blue badge holders parking bay(as signed). These will be located as follows:
 - a) 1 blue badge holders parking bay outside the entrance to nos. 10-18 Matson Court;
 - b) 1 unrestricted parking bay opposite the storage units for nos. 3-9 Matson Court; and
 - c) 3 unrestricted parking bays at the north end of the car park opposite the garages.
- 3. These measures will prevent parking and waiting where it could cause an obstruction, particularly to emergency services and refuse collection vehicles.
- 4. Copies of the Order, which will come into operation from 17th June 2024 and all other relevant documents can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from that date on request by either emailing traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk, or visiting the Highways and Traffic Management office (*by appointment), Low Hall, Argall Avenue, E10 7AS during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, or alternatively documents can be viewed online at: www.walthamforest.gov.uk.content/road-traffic-schemes-and-consultations.
- 5. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the making of the Order, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
