- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under section 84 1. of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended to introduce a 20-m.p.h. speed limit on the following parts of roads:
 - (a) Chingford Mount Road E4 (CMR) between the common boundary of Nos. 266 and 268 CMR and its junction with Chingford Road E4
 - (b) Chingford Road E4 (CR) between its junction with Chingford Mount Road E4 and the common boundary of Nos. 24 and 26 CR E4; and
 - (c) Hall Lane E4 (HL) (north to south arm) between its junction with Hall Lane (west to east arm) and a point 3 metres north of the common boundary of Nos. 303 and 305 HL.

In the case of all roads mentioned above this would be reducing the speed limit from 30 m.p.h..

- Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds 3. that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
