STATEMENT OF REASONS

The single yellow line waiting restrictions are intended to help reduce antisocial behaviour along the road by reducing parking capacity out of business hours to discourage spectators and participants attending gatherings on Argall Avenue.

These measures above are initially being introduced experimentally to assess their effectiveness with a view to making them permanent.

In proposing to make these orders consideration has been given to securing expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular and other traffic.
