

LBWF Young Carers Pathway

From March 2019, all identified young carer/s and their family requiring support will benefit from the following support pathway. As there is a statuary duty on the local authority to be "pro-active in identification" and establish weather they have "support needs", young carers will be able to access support from our dedicated services up to the age of 18. Following their 18th birthday, if a young adult carer continues to have needs and/ or continues in their caring role, they will be transitioned via "Young Carers Transitional Assessment" for a Carers Assessment or Parent Carers Assessment, and continue receiving support from Adult Social Care or SEND services,
