The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended and all other powers enabling, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1. Citation and Commencement**

1.1 This Order shall come into operation for the purposes of –

- (a) the provisions of Article 5 of this Order from 17<sup>th</sup> July 2024;
- (b) the provisions of Article 3 and 4 of this Order in so far as any existing parking provision is revoked, or any new parking provision imposed, on the date on which it is indicated by either the removal, replacement or installation of traffic signs; and
- (c) all other provisions of this Order on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

1.2 This Order may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 217) Order 2024.

**2. Interpretation**

2.1 In this Order

“Council” means the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest;

“map schedule legend” means the map schedule legend attached to the Order of 2019 which, when used in conjunction with a map tile, identifies the specific type of parking places designated by this Order and the specific type of parking place designated by the Order of 2019 (as amended) and, where specified, certain of its governing provisions;

“map tile” means an individual map with a specific tile reference, being part of the map based schedule attached to this Order;

“map based schedule” means a map tile attached to this Order and listed in the Schedule to this Order which depicts the parking places designated by this Order and the parking places designated by the Order of 2019 (as amended) and, in conjunction with either the map schedule legend or a map tile label, or both, identifies the type of each particular parking place and, where specified, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map based schedule and where a parking place is depicted in the map based schedule, that parking place will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data.

“the Order of 2019” means The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019<sup>2</sup>.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2019 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

### **3. Substitution of map tiles**

- 3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2019 shall have effect as though:
  - (a) for the map tiles attached to that Order and specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, there were substituted the map tiles attached to this Order and specified in relation thereto in column 2 of that Schedule; and
  - (b) for the version numbers specified in Schedule 2 to that Order of 2019 in relation to the map tiles referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above there were substituted the version numbers given in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the corresponding map tiles.
- 3.2 The substitution of any map tile referred to in Article 3.1 of this Order will have the effect of revoking any provision designated by a previous version of that map tile and not incorporated into the latest version.

### **4. Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2019 thereto**

- 4.1 Each area on a street identified in a map tile as a parking place and, where applicable, by way of either a map tile label or the map schedule legend, or both, as an area marked out and signed for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in the Order of 2019 in relation to that type of parking place, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 Unless otherwise so identified, a parking place shall be bounded on one side of its length by the edge of the carriageway and be an area marked either by a traffic sign or by another method of indicating the extent of a parking place as specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>3</sup>.
- 4.3 The provisions of the Order of 2019 (other than Articles 4 and 14) shall apply to an area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order.

### **5. Placing of Traffic Signs, etc**

The Council shall:

- (a) place and maintain traffic signs or other appropriate markings on the surface of the street indicating the limits of each parking place designated by this Order; and
- (b) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order makes an incremental change to the Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019 map tiles to reflect changes in:

- (a) **Billet Road (BT) E17** – north side – displacement of 6.6m of permit parking space outside Nos. 352/354 BT.
- (b) **Cooper Avenue (CP) E17** – south-east side – removal of 5.6 m of 'HHN' permit parking space outside No. 39 CP.
- (c) **Farmilo Road (FM) E17** – north-west side – removal of 6.6m of 'QB' permit parking space outside No. 113 FM.
- (d) **Gaywood Road (GY) E17** – east side – extension of permit parking space opposite Nos. 37/39 GY to permit parking space for 'HS' permit holders only operating Mon-Sat 8am to 6.30pm.
- (e) **Hainault Road (HT) E11** – south-east side – removal of 7m of 'LSN' permit parking space outside Nos. 216 to 220 HT

**The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 213) Order 2024**

Made 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024

Coming into operation see Article 1.1

The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended and all other powers enabling, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1. Citation and Commencement**

1.1 This Order shall come into operation for the purposes of –

- (a) the provisions of Article 6 of this Order from 17<sup>th</sup> July 2024;
- (b) the provisions of Article 3, 4 and 5 of this Order in so far as any existing parking or loading provision, waiting or loading restriction, or no stopping restriction is revoked, or any new parking or loading provision, waiting or loading restriction or no stopping restriction imposed, on the date on which it is indicated by either the removal, replacement or installation of traffic signs; and
- (c) all other provisions of this Order on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

1.2 This Order may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 213) Order 2024.

**2. Interpretation**

2.1 In this Order

“Council” means the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest;

“map schedule legend” means the map schedule legend attached to the Order of 2019 which, when used in conjunction with a map tile, identifies the specific type of parking place designated by or waiting restriction provided by this Order and the specific type of parking place or loading place designated by or waiting, loading or stopping restriction provided by the Order of 2019 (as amended) and, where specified, certain of their governing provisions;

“map tile” means an individual map with a specific tile reference, being part of the map based schedule attached to this Order;

“map based schedule” means a map tile attached to this Order and listed in the Schedule to this Order which depicts the parking places designated by and the waiting restrictions provided by this Order and the parking places and loading places designated by and waiting, loading and stopping restrictions provided by the Order of 2019 (as amended) and, in conjunction with either the map schedule legend or a map tile label, or both, identifies the type of each particular parking place or loading place or length of waiting, loading or stopping restrictions, and, where specified, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map based schedule and where a parking place, loading place or length of waiting, loading or stopping restrictions is depicted in the map based schedule, that parking place, loading place or length of waiting, loading or stopping restrictions will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data.

“the Order of 2019” means The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2019<sup>2</sup>.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

- (b) for the revision numbers specified in Schedule 2 to that Order of 2019 in relation to the map tiles referred to in sub-paragraph (a) above there were substituted the revision numbers given in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the corresponding map tiles.
- 3.2 The substitution of any map tile referred to in Article 3.1 of this Order will have the effect of revoking any provision provided or designated by a previous version of that map tile and not incorporated into the latest version.

### **4. Waiting and loading restrictions applicable in restricted streets**

- 4.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2019 shall have effect as though any waiting or loading restriction, or both, identified in a map tile and, where applicable, by way of either a map tile label or the map schedule legend, or both, and marked out and signed as a waiting restriction or loading restriction, or both, shall be construed as though it were a restricted street referred to in the Order of 2019.

### **5. Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2019 thereto**

- 5.1 Each area on a street identified in a map tile as a parking place and, where applicable, by way of either a map tile label or the map schedule legend, or both, as an area marked out and signed for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in the Order of 2019 in relation to that type of parking place, is designated as a parking place.

- 5.2 Unless otherwise so identified, a parking place shall be bounded on one side of its length by the edge of the carriageway and be an area marked either by a traffic sign or by another method of indicating the extent of a parking place as specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>3</sup>.
- 5.3 The provisions of the Order of 2019 (other than Articles 4 and 14) shall apply to an area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order;

**6. Placing of Traffic Signs, etc**

The Council shall:

- (a) place and maintain adequate and appropriate traffic signs or other appropriate markings on the surface of the street indicating the parking provisions and waiting restrictions imposed by this Order; and
- (b) carry out such other work as is reasonably required by the Order of 2019 for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of such parking provision and waiting restrictions.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order makes amendments to the Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2019 to replace certain map tiles attached to that Order to reflect changes in:

- (a) **Billet Road (BT) E17** – north side – extension of the single yellow line waiting restrictions (syl) outside No. 356 BT eastwards by 6.6 metres(m) operating Mon-Fri 8am to 6.30pm.
- (b) **Cooper Avenue (CP) E17** – south-east side – addition of 5.6 m of syl operating Mon-Fri 8am to 6.30pm outside No. 39 CP
- (c) **Cranbrook Mews E17 – northern side:**
  - (i) Removal of all loading places (bays) and disabled person's parking places between its junction with South Grove and Courtenay Place and in place of these bays double yellow line "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions; except between the rear of (1) Nos. 82 to 88 High Street (HGH) (18m); Nos. 50 to 52A (HGH) (17.5m) and Nos. 44 and 46 HGH (18.5m) where double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions (dyls) apply only; and
  - (ii) Provide double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions (dyls) outside the drop kerb access point to the rear of Nos. 46 and 48 HGH.
- (d) **Farmilo Road (FM) E17** – north-west side - a 6.6m disabled person's parking place operating "at all times" outside No.113
- (e) **Gaywood Road (GY) E17** – east side – removal of the whole syl opposite Nos. 37/39.
- (f) **Hainault Road (HT) E11** – south-east side – addition of a syl for 7m operating Mon-Fri 10am to 4pm 'outside Nos. 216 to 220 HT to and
- (g) **Lockwood Way E17** (private road) – north side – conversion of Free Short Stay parking to double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions – the whole side.
