

# SUTHERLAND ROAD PUBLIC REALM IMPROVEMENTS SCHEME

## PHASE 2 – ST ANDREWS ROAD (EAST)

**Waltham Forest Council is in the process of delivering public realm improvements in Sutherland Road which will transform it into a more enjoyable place for residents, businesses and visitors. The scheme is supported by the Greater London Authority Housing Zone programme and aims to improve the overall look and feel of the area, encourage walking and cycling, and improve access for people with mobility aids and pushchairs.**

In spring 2023 we held a series of engagement events with residents and key stakeholders to help us understand concerns and aspirations in the area. During this process, residents told us key issues in the area were parking, traffic flow, the condition of the road, difficulties walking and cycling in the area, narrow footways and a lack of green space and trees.

We used this feedback to inform proposals to improve



the area. In July 2023, the community were invited to take part in a public consultation to comment on these plans. We wrote to you with the outcome of the consultation in October 2023.

Following the completion of statutory consultation, we started construction on improvements in Sutherland Road and to the western end of St Andrews Road (from Blackhorse Lane to Papermill Place) in December 2023. These improvements are referred to as Phase 1.


We are now planning to progress our plans for Phase 2, which include improvements on the eastern end of St Andrews Road, from Papermill Place to Higham Hill Road.

## PHASE 2 PROPOSALS

Phase 2 proposals include the widening of footways, decluttering street furniture and installation of footway buildouts with garden beds. To accommodate these improvements, the parking layout will need to be changed. Four Pay and Display spaces will be converted to resident parking to ensure the number of CPZ bays remains the same.

## NEXT STEPS

Now the scheme design has been finalised, it is subject to statutory consultation. This process involves advertising the necessary Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) associated with the changes to parking bays and yellow lines required to deliver the scheme. The TMOs will be advertised in the East London and West Essex Guardian on September 12 2024. Street notices will also be displayed in the area with details of the changes.

The statutory consultation will take place between 12 September and 3 October 2024. During this time local people can write to us with comments on the final scheme. Following statutory consultation, we will review any feedback received and write to the local community again with an update on the planned works.
