#### TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (Amendment No. 19) Traffic Order 2024

#### Made 12th September 2024

Coming into operation 23rd September 2024

The Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), as amended and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

#### 1. Citation and Commencement

1.1 This Order shall come into operation on **23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024** and may be cited as The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) (Amendment No. 19) Traffic Order 2024.

#### 2. In this Order,

- 2.1 the expression "Order of 2021" means The Waltham Forest (Prescribed Routes) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) Traffic Order 2021(**b**);
- 2.2 any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment; and
- 2.3 unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2021 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

#### 3. Amendment to the Order of 2021

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity to anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or any omission before the coming into operation of this Order items 57 and 58 in the Schedule of the Order of 2021 are substituted with the items similarly numbered 57 and 58 respectively as set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order;

### 4. Placing of Traffic Signs, etc

The Council shall:

- 4.1 place and maintain adequate and appropriate traffic signs indicating the prescribed routes imposed by this Order; and
- 4.2 carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of such prescribed routes.
