STATEMENT OF REASONS

The reduction of parking (including a car club bay) on Forest Road, east of the Fulbourne Road junction, is necessary to enable the introduction of sustainable public spaces and segregated cycle tracks. Additional double yellow lines and loading restrictions will also be necessary in currently uncontrolled areas.
