**The Waltham Forest (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 233) Order 2024  
The Waltham Forest (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping  
Restrictions) (Amendment No. 229) Order 2024**

**NOTICE IS GIVEN** that the London Borough of Waltham Forest (the ‘Council’) on **9<sup>th</sup> December 2024** made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The general effect of the Orders will be in **Forest Road E17** (north side) – to remove the ‘car club permit holders only’ bay situated to the east of Fulbourne Road.

Note: the uncontrolled kerb side parking space immediately northeast of that car club bay will also be removed and replaced by an extension of the existing bus stop clearway.

Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation from **11<sup>th</sup> December 2024** and all other relevant documents can be inspected until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from that date on request by either emailing [traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk](mailto:traffic.scheme@walthamforest.gov.uk), or visiting the Highways and Traffic Management office (\*by appointment), Low Hall, Argall Avenue, E10 7AS during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, or alternatively documents can be viewed online at: [www.walthamforest.gov.uk/content/road-traffic-schemes-and-consultations](http://www.walthamforest.gov.uk/content/road-traffic-schemes-and-consultations).

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
